Environmental Policy Statement

Balcombe Pest Control in providing pest control services will manage pesticides in a responsible manner that minimises potential environmental and health impacts and fully considers the following: legal requirements, customer expectations and concerns, short and long term benefits, cost and liabilities, and viable material and process alternatives.

Public awareness and concerns regarding the use of Pesticides and increasing costs of disposal means that continued reduction in usage by greater attention to Integrated Pest management and working in partnership with customers provides both environmental and mutual long-term business advantages. For example greater emphasis on proofing of premises significantly reduces pest ingress and hence reduces the requirement for the use of Pesticides minimising risks and saving money.

All Balcombe Pest control employees have a responsibility in undertaking their work to advise our customers of how they can help to minimise pest occurrence through good practice in undertaking their own business.

Management will inform and coach staff as to the adoption of good working practice and Inform them of new products and services which will be of benefit to our customers and the environment.

The directors and staff have joint responsibility to ensure that the company objectives with regard to health and safety and environmental policy are fulfilled.
